2016 Copperhead District Cast Iron Chef Award

REQUIREMENTS:

Many parents and Scouters have a tremendous impact upon Scouting through their culinary skills, but may not be well known throughout the district. Their work is very important and directly affects the quality of Scouting in their unit. The Cast Iron Chef Award is intended to properly recognize individuals who have excelled in their outdoor mastery of Dutch oven cooking. At this time, any adult may be nominated whether they are registered or not in a Scouting unit. If this person is not currently registered in BSA they must have a son or daughter registered in BSA. (We may extend a similar award to youth in the future). This award is open to adults in all program levels; Cubs, Scouts and Venturers. The nominations should answer such questions as:

1. What is this individual's "famed" dish?
2. Without giving away the recipe, what are some major ingredients in this recipe?
3. How has this person helped youth in their unit learn how to cook and care for a Dutch oven?
4. How has this leader encouraged other adults in the unit to improve their proficiency with Dutch oven cooking?

Information given should relate only to **unit level** service. The unit is responsible for securing the winning recipient's attendance at the District Recognition Dinner without telling him/her why they are to attend, and inviting enough family and friends to properly honor them. The review committee will let the winning nominator know in plenty of time to ensure the winner's attendance.
